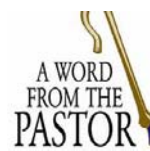

I was visiting a good friend of mine who is also a Methodist minister. He took me over to his church to see it, at which time I also met some of his parishioners who were wearing badges describing their works. It was interesting how he introduced them: "This is Mrs. Jones, whose ministry is bread-making for the mass." "This is Mr. Johnson, whose ministry is taking care of the grounds." "And meet Mrs. Harrison, whose ministry is praying for the sick." I asked him about his use of the word "ministry" for all these different people, to which he responded: "We believe that God gave us all a ministry! And that is why they all wear badges naming their ministry when they come to church!" I was so very impressed with this and wondered why in the Catholic Church we do not do the same? After all, in today's 2<sup>nd</sup> reading St. Paul reminds us that "in the Holy Spirit there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone." Why is it in our church we mostly think of the priest as the only one doing ministry? Our faith teaches us that all of us share in Christ's priesthood, each of us having a different function or job to do. When people ask me for a blessing, I always ask them for their blessing in return. Some look startled when I ask for their blessing, assuming that my blessing is more powerful than their blessing. We have to be careful not to elevate the priest to a higher level than the rest of the people of God; we can make an idolatry of roles that is neither wise nor healthy. In light of this tendency in our church, I can understand better why St. Francis of Assisi did not choose to be a priest, although he always respected the priest for giving us the Eucharist. He did not want to be elevated above other people which could harm the virtue of humility. I can understand his choice. St. Paul continues that we are "One body which has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many are one body, so also Christ." In other words, we are Christ's body and so each of us needs to do our part! As we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, let each of us ask the Holy Spirit what is our role that is needed to build the body of Christ! ~ Fr. John

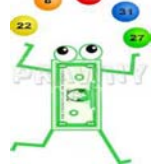


The annual Micah Awards Dinner will be on Saturday, June 10th, at the Holy Cross Manor.
